#### Welcome Home Vietnam Veterans Day

At 11:00 am on Saturday, March 29, 2014 the Veterans Memorial Park and Museum Committee, Inc. along with The Veterans Council of Hillsborough County, Inc. will be conducting the annual Welcome Home Vietnam Veterans Day ceremony located at Veterans Memorial Park, 3602 US Highway 301 North, Tampa, Florida. This annual event is to honor all the Veterans who have served in Vietnam, including a special remembrance for those who did not make it back. The Rolling Thunder, Florida Chapter 11 Color Guard will present Colors and the National Anthem will be sung by Hillsborough County Firefighter and Retired U. S. Marine Thurnell (Chip) Shields. The invocation and benediction will be offered by Ordained Minister Linda Pugsley, former U. S. Air Force Nurse and Vietnam Veteran. Featured speakers will discuss the 50th Anniversary of the Vietnam War and the Department of Defense Announcement of the 50th Anniversary of the Vietnam War Program. We were recognized by the DoD for our willingness to assist and support a grateful nation in thanking and honoring our Vietnam Veterans and their families.

Keynote speakers for this program are Major General David J. Scott, U. S. Air Force, Retired, former Deputy Director of Special Operations Command's Special Operations and Dr. Richard M.Swier, Ed.D., LTC, U. S. Army, Retired. Rolling Thunder, Florida Chapter 11 will conduct the POW/MIA Missing Man Ceremony and Medal of Honor Remembrance followed by a rifle salute and TAPS by the Riverview Detachment of the Marine Corps League. Following the ceremony, The Suncoast Vietnam Veterans Chapter will conduct a reenactment of the Last Patrol in the closing days of the Vietnam War. This event is open to the public and all are encouraged to attend to show your support for America's service members. The James A Haley VA Hospital Mobile bus will be on site for the program on the 29th. Our Veterans & families need to
